

2025 SPECIAL COLLECTIONS SCHEDULE

Revised 4.25.2024

In accord with Canon 1266, the following collections are to be taken up in all churches, missions, chapels, and oratories within the diocese, including those belonging to religious institutes. Only with the permission of the Vicar General can certain exceptions be made.

An exchange check, made out to the "Diocese of San Jose," must be *promptly* sent to the Chancery, no later than six weeks from the date of collection.

^{***}Archdiocese for the Military Services, USA: To be taken up every three years. (Next scheduled collection is in 2028.)
